01 10 REASONS TO TRAVEL SUSTAINABLY



Nowadays, the process of picking, gathering, and transporting waste thrown by individuals with a conscious and unconscious mind has become one of the most challenging problems to solve in waste management. In countryside areas, less than 1% of waste is recycled, 99% of waste is buried under the local soil. Problems of collecting and transporting waste, adding employment, and organizing logistics are impossible to solve fully in rural areas. Therefore, travelers' primary responsibilities should be to avoid producing waste from the beginning, classify waste at the final process, and keep it to a minimum.

PREVENTS FROM PRODUCING WASTE IN LANDFILLS OF RURAL AREAS

According to studies, tourists generate up to twice as much waste as locals (Sustainable Travel International, 2020). So, generating less waste or traveling with zero waste will reduce the local landfill space.

PREVENTS AIR, SOIL, AND WATER POLLUTION

Waste impacts negatively to the air, soil, and water before they totally degrade in nature. Particularly, plastic wraps and bags are unable to decompose completely in the soil. Moreover, they become smaller nanoparticles but never disappear totally. Our 20-minute use of plastic wraps can last for over 200 years in the environment. If you travel and enjoy natural beauty, please express your gratitude to the earth by refusing to produce waste as much as possible.

CONSERVES BIODIVERSITY

Waste from travelers can harm biodiversity and could be fatal in some cases. You may have seen the pictures of birds with metals stuck in their stomach and animals with abnormal body growth because they were trapped in plastic pieces. Try to be responsible for your waste when you travel to avoid disturbing wildlife.

CONSERVES NON-REGENERATIVE RESOURCES

Conserving all forms of mineral resources and the wealth of land and forest will sustain resources, as well as reduce the usage of land, plants and water. Refusing and reducing waste helps to conserve non-renewable and non-regenerative resources and safeguards biodiversity. It is a responsibility to save resource for future generations.

REDUCES GREENHOUSE GAS EMISSIONS

Refusing to use the most waste-producing types of packaging or sorting out waste helps to avoid using the production of new raw materials and reduces greenhouse gas emissions comparably by up to 37% to 100%.

PROTECTS GROUNDWATER

Reducing the amount of waste prevents the penetration of pollution to soil and groundwater. When waste is dumped with water, it forms organic and non-organic harmful compounds. Those compounds contaminate an essential part of life forms in groundwater. In addition, if the toxic substances pollutes rivers and other living organisms, it will cause chronic diseases in people. For example, the chemicals will immediately affect health if it release heavy metals.

PREVENTS VARIOUS KINDS OF DISEASES

Waste-derived hazardous elements are most likely to trigger allergies, digestive issues, blood contamination, respiratory, and chronic diseases. Furthermore, improper waste issues have negatively impacts social and emotional wellbeing. The waste impacts travelers' comfort and mental state the most.

PRESERVES MONGOLIAN TRADITIONAL NOMADIC CULTURE

Mongolia is well known for its nomadic traditions. The main perspective of the nomadic lifestyle has been to minimize consumption, and recycle resources as much as possible. This traditional culture should be inherited and preserved for the future generations.

REDUCES ECOLOGICAL AND CARBON FOOTPRINT

According to research, Mongolians' ecological footprints are 2.6 times greater than the global average. Every citizen and household must prioritize minimizing their ecological footprints.

Traveling without waste or reducing ecological footprints leaves the most significant wealth for our future.



02

PLANNING AND PREPARING FOR TRAVELING WITHOUT PRODUCING WASTE



Instead of throwing away the disposable items, replace it with the following reusables. For example, cotton bags can be used instead of plastic bags of products such as rice and vegetables. Additionally, when you purchase items arrange them to be recyclable and give in nearby recycling points. The following products are reusable solution for your travel:



SPOON, FORK, KNIFE, STRAW: These items are must-carry things. Refusing to use disposables can prevent building up the amount of waste. Disposable straws can be replaced by metal, bamboo, and silicone straws.



HEAT PRESERVING CUP: Coffee is a vital part of our daily lives and serves as a major source of energy. Unfortunately, it leads us to consume more and more disposable products. If we reuse our cups, we will save 500 disposable cups annually.



WATER BOTTLE: One efficient way to avoid plastic is to carry a water bottle. Reusable bottle will significantly help to reduce the 1.5 billion plastic bottles that are sold every day worldwide. We use many disposable items daily, but only around 10% are recycled. That not-recycled waste ends in landfills, or even seas and oceans.



WATER PURIFIER: Water purifier is the best solution to refuse plastic bottles.




BAMBOO TOOTHBRUSH: The toothbrush consists of different types of plastics. Due to the combination of different plastics, the toothbrush is one of the most complicated products to be recycled. Environmentally friendly bamboo-toothbrush can be found easily nowadays.



SHAMPOO AND CONDITIONER BARS : Refusing to use shampoo and conditioner with plastic packaging can prevent a considerable amount of waste. Shampoo bars can be used around 80 times that equals 2-3 bottles of liquid shampoo.



COTTON BAGS: Cotton bags are much more sustainable, and practical than plastic bags. Carry several cotton bags and wash for your next use.



REUSABLE LUNCH BOX: Plastic food containers are not biodegradable, and degrades in nature for hundreds of years.



ZERO WASTE DISHWASHER: Using the wooden dish brushes and biodegradable dish sponges can reduce the amount of plastics, and it prevents to produce hazardous chemical substances.



ECO DETERGENT: Eco detergents are environmentally friendly and do not pollute, unlike conventional detergents. If it dissolves in water ways it is less contaminating than conventional detergents.



SANITARY PAD: Use a menstrual cup or washable cotton pad instead of a disposable sanitary pads. It prevents producing waste and keeps you comfortable throughout the trip. It is economical as well.



ECO DIAPER: When traveling with your toddlers, try to use cotton diapers. Diapers cannot be thrown in nature directly due to its' harmful components. Please remember that disposable diapers must be disposed of in proper waste spots and bins.



TISSUE AND TOILET PAPER: Most wet tissues are made of plastics and decomposed into nature many years. Try to refuse buying wet tissues as much as possible and use cotton towels instead. It is very disturbing to find toilet papers in natural environment. Additionally, try to use recycled or eco friendly toilet papers.





BATTERY CHARGER: The battery contains toxic substances such as cadmium, lead, mercury, and lithium. A battery AA has potential to pollute 4-meter square, 800-thousand-liter water. It should be separated from other waste and taken to nearby hazardous waste collection points.



BIN BAGS: Keep a durable bag in your car that can be hung on your car's spare tire and leave it waste landfills or recycling centers/points. It save a space in your car.



BIO MIXTURES WITH ACTIVE WITH MICROORGANISMS FOR FERTILIZERS: This mixture can be used to turn any food waste and toilet dumps into fertilizer when you travel countryside.

03 STEPS SORT TRAVEL WASTE



If it is impossible to prevent producing waste during the trip, sort waste and take it to the closest recycling collection points.

You will find a list of addresses of Mongolian recycling centers in this guide.



PLASTIC

All kinds of bottles of beverages, disposable spoons, forks, shampoo bottles, any plastic wrappings of dairy products, bread, and other flour-based food, tape, /PET, HDPE, PVC, LDPE, PS, PP/, Styrofoam, solid and soft plastic packaging, and elastic boxing.

Caution:

- Reduce the size of plastic packaging
- Be clean



PAPER

Letter, notebook, newspaper, and other papers such as brown and carton papers and an egg box.

Caution:

- No chalk
- No staples
- No tapes



GLASS / CAN:

Aluminum drink cans, any glass for window, mirror, food products, alcohol, and beverage.

Caution:

- Be clean
- Compress cans to help recycling them.



NON-RECYCLABLE WASTE

PAPER Papers with chalk, gloss coated paper, and greasy paper.

PLASTIC Plastics that cannot be recycled in our country are zip-lock plastic bags, candy wrappers, chips' plastic bags, etc. However, please keep in mind that plastic bags should be discarded at dump spots and not be spread by wind because plastic bags are never completely decomposed in nature.

ALTERNATIVE WAYS TO MAKE YOUR TRAVEL MORE SUSTAINABLE



PROTECTING WATER, SOIL, AND ANIMALS

The act starts with a mindset of protecting the nature. You should try not to pollute and harm. Think about how much your actions can impact mother nature. Here are some important reminders:

- 🍷 For washing clothes, take water from the river in the bucket and avoid rinsing in the river directly. Use handmade eco soaps and detergents with fewer ingredients that will cause less harm to nature.
- 🍷 Avoid to cut flowers, plants and trees. It is recommended to use fallen branches or woods for a campfire.
- 🍷 Try to not disturb or harm any kinds of animals, from insects to all different species of animals. Leaving them in peace is essential. We should remember how our ancestors respected mother nature.
- 🍷 Please raise awareness among youth and children that we co-exist and share our earth with animals and the environment.



AVOID CREATING NEW ROADS/ROUTES

When people create roads, the ecosystem is destroyed in this way. Therefore, please, choose known roads following safety regulations.



ABOUT USING TOILETS

Human urine contains a rich amount of nitrogen, phosphorus, and other beneficial substances. When urine is composed correctly, it can become an efficient fertilizer. However, it can boost the growth of algae and weeds in the medium such as water and rivers. The risk of leaving feces directly in the wild can pollute groundwater resources. Human feces can spread Giardia, Salmonella, E. coli, etc. Also, bacteria from a person with liver inflammation can be transferred from human to animal. Toilet paper takes more than 5 months to decompose in nature and wet tissue takes more than 100 years. Extra toilet paper layers and colors make toilet papers decompose even longer. Biodegradable or recycled toilet paper with no color is preferred for traveling. Wet tissues should not be left in the open nature and should be disposed of with other waste. Following actions are encouraged to be adopted.

- 🍷 Travel to places with proper toilets. Wait until reaching the resting place, gas station, restaurant, or any other closest places with a toilet.
- 🍷 Bring portable toilets when traveling. You can buy portable toilets like we prepare our tents.
- 🍷 There is a method to dig a hole, use it as a toilet and bury it before leaving the camping site when traveling. This hole should be made far from the roots of trees and riverbanks. Keep in mind that nothing other than human excretion can be buried with it.
- 🍷 There is a special purpose towel that is antibacterial, and the other side is waterproof for women peeing. Professional climbers use that. Also, keeping a normal towel in a small bag is possible.

THE BENEFITS OF BUYING LOCAL PRODUCTS AND SEVERAL WAYS TO REDUCE FOOD WASTE.

Food production accounts for one-fourth of greenhouse gas production. It is carried out through multiple steps from the farming and the agriculture for customers. These processes are a contributing factor to our ecological carbon footprint. Unfortunately, the ecological carbon footprint gets doubled when we travel.

Research indicates that the buried food leftovers releases methane gas, which is 21 times more harmful than carbon dioxide. Please, follow and utilize the following recommendations while traveling:

- 🍴 Order the proper amount of food for the people traveling to make sure there is no food is wasted, as much as possible.
- 🍴 Purchase local foods. It has many benefits, such as supporting local livelihoods, and reducing transportation cost and electrical consumption.
- 🍴 Researchers found that reducing meat consumption is one of the most significant ways to help global warming and reduce our carbon footprint. Animals become meat after several years of consuming grass, wheat, and water resources. Consuming less meat is important to reduce carbon footprint.
- 🍴 Once there is food waste, the best solution is to use food waste as a soil fertilizer. Composting at home must be done for 6-8 weeks and up to a year. For travelers, try to carry Bio Eco's microbial-activated liquid for composting. The liquid fertilizer is easily used to spray food waste. - 🍴 If composting is impossible, liquid food should be disposed in a toilet or food fertilizing tank. Please put it in the available food waste bins at the tour camps.



BUILD AN ENVIRONMENTALLY FRIENDLY AND SAFE CAMPFIRE

The best way to prevent soil erosion and wildfire is to avoid any activities that involve fire. If you must ignite a fire, you need to choose the place carefully or use the previous fire spot. After it, please check up whether it is extinguished.



BE A MINIMALIST!
